

End User License Agreement (EULA) for BIC Software

This End-User License Agreement ("**EULA**") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity, also referred to as "**Licensee**" or "**you**") and

Business Innovation Consultants B.V., a company organized and existing under the laws of the Netherlands, with registered offices at Elburg, the Netherlands ("**BIC**")

for the purpose of obtaining usage rights by Licensee to the BIC Software. In this EULA, "**BIC Software**" means: any computer software, including any accompanying "online" or electronic documentation, which may or may not be embedded in Hardware.

In this EULA, "**Hardware**" means: any physical good (such as hardware) purchased by you from Business Innovation Consultants BV (**BIC**) or a subsidiary of BIC or distributor of BIC.

By using or copying the BIC Software for any other purpose than evaluating whether the BIC Software can be installed, Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This EULA represents the entire agreement concerning the BIC Software between Licensee and BIC and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation or understanding between Licensee and BIC relating to the BIC Software.

If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, you are not allowed to install or to use the BIC Software, other than for the purpose of evaluating whether the BIC Software can be installed.

The BIC Software is protected by Dutch copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The BIC Software is licensed to you, not sold.

GRANT OF LICENSE

The use of the BIC Software is licensed to Licensee as follows:

(a) Installation and Use.

BIC grants Licensee the non-exclusive, non-transferable right to install and use the BIC Software on a computer system or to use it in the Hardware for which the BIC Software was designed. This right of use is based on a pay per month model whereby credit can be bought; any bought credit will expire after three years and provided that the use takes place within the context of the use described in the documentation accompanying the BIC Software.

Installation, other than for the purpose of evaluating whether the BIC Software can be installed, and use of BIC Software shall only take place: (i) after Licensee has signed this EULA and BIC has received the signed EULA back from its distributor; and – if applicable as such - (ii) after Licensee received from BIC - and is using - an activation code ("**Key**").

(b) Backup Copies.

Licensee is allowed to make copies of the BIC Software as may be reasonably necessary for backup and archival purposes, provided that such backups and/or archives are destroyed after a term of twenty-five (25) years after the first installation of the BIC Software.

OTHER LICENSEE RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS

(a) Maintenance of Copyright Notices.

Licensee shall not remove or delete any proprietary notices from the BIC Software and shall ensure that similar proprietary notices are retained on any copies of the BIC Software.

(b) Technology export controls.

Licensee is not allowed and shall not install and use the BIC Software if the usage is in violation of the Wassenaar Arrangement on Export Controls for Conventional Arms and Dual-Use Goods and Technologies and/or subsequent transpositions of it into European or national law.

(c) Prohibition on Reverse Engineering, Decompilation, and Disassembly.

Except to the extent permitted by applicable law, you shall not reverse engineer, disassemble or decompile the BIC Software for any purpose.

(d) Selling, Rental, Lease or Lending.

Except to the extent permitted by applicable law, Licensee shall not sell, rent, lease, lend or otherwise transfer: the BIC Software or any of its sources and/or any of its parts and/or – if applicable - the Key.

(e) Support Services.

BIC may provide Licensee with Support Services related to the BIC Software ("**Support Services**"). Any supplemental software code or documentation provided to Licensee as part of the Support Services shall be considered part of the BIC Software and shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this EULA.

(f) Compliance with Applicable Laws.

Licensee must comply with all applicable laws regarding use of the BIC Software.

(g) Restrictions on the right granted to use the BIC Software.

Without prejudice to the other clauses in this EULA, Licensee shall observe the restrictions on the rights granted to use the BIC Software in terms of the maximum number of cores and the maximum number of simultaneous end-users the BIC Software is licensed for. To the extent permitted by applicable law, under no circumstances shall the Licensee remove or circumvent provisions intended to protect the BIC Software in this respect.

TERMINATION

Without prejudice to any other rights, BIC may terminate this EULA (including – if applicable - the right granted to use the Key), without giving any reason, if Licensee fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this EULA and/or Licensee's use of the BIC Software gives cause for bad publicity for BIC. In such event, Licensee shall not be entitled to any costs, losses or damages incurred as a result of such termination and Licensee shall immediately destroy all copies of the BIC Software and – if applicable - Key(s) in its possession and shall provide sufficient and valid proof to BIC that all copies of the BIC Software and – if applicable - Keys(s) in possession of Licensee have been destroyed.

Licensee may terminate this EULA at any time taking into account one (1) month written notice to be provided to BIC prior to such termination. In such case, BIC shall be entitled to receive full compensation for all services performed hereunder prior to the date of termination, or otherwise, as long as Licensee does not provide sufficient and valid proof that all copies of the BIC Software and/or Key(s) in possession of Licensee are returned to BIC or destroyed, with records kept of such destruction.

COPYRIGHT AND OTHER INTELLECTUAL RIGHTS

The BIC Software and any copies thereof consist of proprietary products which are and shall remain the exclusive property of BIC and/or its licensor, and the Licensee shall have no right, title or interest therein except as expressly set forth in this EULA.

All title and intellectual property rights in and to the content which may be accessed through use of the BIC Software is the property of the respective content owner and may be protected by applicable copyright or other intellectual property laws and treaties. This EULA does not grant Licensee any rights to use such content. BIC reserves all rights and titles not expressly granted under this EULA.

NO WARRANTIES

BIC expressly disclaims any warranty with regard to the BIC Software (including but not limited to documentation related to the BIC Software) and related BIC Software Support Services. The BIC Software (including any documentation and – if applicable - Key(s) relating to it), and related BIC Software Support Services are provided 'as is' without any express or implied warranty of any kind, including but not limited to any warranties of merchantability, non-infringement, or fitness for a particular purpose. BIC does not warrant or assume responsibility or liability for the accuracy or completeness of any information, text, graphics, links, advices or other items contained within or created by (using) the BIC Software or related BIC Software Support Services. BIC makes no warranties with respect to any harm that may be caused by the transmission of a computer virus, worm, time bomb, logic bomb, malware or any other of such computer program. BIC further expressly disclaims any warranty or representation to any third party.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

To the extent permitted by applicable law, in no event shall BIC be liable for any damages (including, without limitation, lost profits, business interruption, or lost information) arising out of any use, any third parties use, any inability to use and any limitations in the use of the BIC Software and/or arising out of the provisioning of the BIC Software Support Services, even if BIC has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

The liability of BIC to Licensee, whether in contract, negligence, other tort or otherwise arising out of or in connection with this EULA is limited to direct damages for an amount equal to the license fee paid by Licensee. BIC's liability for indirect or consequential damages is explicitly excluded. Indirect or consequential damages include but are not limited to consequential loss, lost profits, lost revenue, lost contracts, lost anticipated savings, loss of goodwill, reputational damage, damage through business interruptions, mutilation or loss of data, loss of business opportunities. BIC excludes any liability with respect to the content of the BIC Software or any part thereof, including but not limited to errors or omissions contained therein, libel-infringements of rights of publicity and/or privacy and/or trademark rights, business interruption, personal injury, loss of privacy, loss of moral rights or the disclosure of confidential information. Furthermore, BIC excludes any liability to any third party. The limitations mentioned in the preceding sentences of this paragraph shall not apply if and for so far as the damage is the result of willful misconduct or deliberate recklessness by BIC or its managers or if and insofar this is in conflict with mandatory Dutch law.

THIRD PARTY SOFTWARE ASSOCIATED WITH THE BIC SOFTWARE

Licensee acknowledges that the BIC Software contains third party software components. Some of these components are licensed under the associated third party software licenses as specified by means of hyperlinks in the EULA ANNEX. By installing, copying or otherwise using (parts of) the BIC Software, Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms of these third party licenses as well. If you do not agree to these terms, you are not allowed to install or to use the BIC Software.
